Dear Friend of Safe Harbor:

As you know, Safe Harbor serves children and teenagers who have been abused, which is something that most people can find hard to talk to about. We are here for children and families during some of their most difficult times.

On any day we might serve a 7 year-old who has been sexually assaulted by a step-parent; a 10 year-old who takes care of their younger siblings because their parents are incapacitated by the opioid epidemic; a 14 year-old who is exploited over the internet by an adult posing as a teenager; an 8 year-old who called 911



because his mother was getting choked by her boyfriend and couldn't breathe; or a 4 year-old wearing a sling because of a broken clavicle, due to abuse. This is difficult stuff to hear about, I know. Our job at Safe Harbor is to not turn away, and **I'm so glad you are not turning away either**.

Around 400 children walk through our doors each year. It's our response to their trauma that makes a long-term difference in their lives. Safe Harbor offers compassion, justice, healing, and hope. Our coordinated response helps kids stay in school, become healthy and thriving, and puts them on the road to a productive and happy life.

But we can't do it alone. We rely on the generosity of private funders to keep our doors open – governmental grants are not enough. YOUR gift this year can make a huge impact on a child going through an incredibly difficult ordeal. We provide crisis counseling, trauma-informed forensic interviews, advocacy, child life services, emergency assistance (gas, food, housing), mental health services and referrals to medical exams and long-term counseling.

Here are a few examples of what various gifts could provide at Safe Harbor:

\$50 - Gift cards for Gas, Food & Clothes

\$100 - Case Planning for At-Risk Children or Emergency Housing

\$150 - Trauma-focused Therapy Session

\$300 - Interpretation Services for Forensic Interviews

\$500 - 1 full appointment: forensic interview, advocacy & child life services
